Programme of Hockey Camps – 2009-10

Currently the programme is intended as follows:



CAMP 1 – 2 Days, 28th, 29th, May 2009



“Development for current/potential county players and above”

The camp will operate for ages 11-13 (1996-1998 birthdays) and 14-16 (1993-1995 birthdays), both boys and girls

Important information for RHC Camps

- Camp will begin at 10am and finish at 4pm (please report to registration each day)
- Children need to bring:
 - Change of clothing
 - Packed lunch
 - Plenty to drink
 - Shin Pads
 - Mouth Guards
 - Trainers or proper Astroturf shoes (not studded football boots)
- All other equipment (and sticks if required) will be provided by the coaches
